## New Website Coming This Summer

This summer the Council of Juvenile Correctional Administrators (CJCA) will introduce a new website that will unify each of its programs' sites (CJCA, PbS and CbS) into one common website. Our team has been working hard on the design of the website and we are excited about the opportunities it provides for the enhancement of PbS improvement efforts. The website will include customized home pages based on user settings and several additional features including:

- Advanced data tools that address data accuracy and reliability at the time of data entry rather than during the draft site report period.
- Increased opportunities for pre-population of forms to streamline

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and reduce data entry

- Unified logins for project, agency and site staff
- Smart pre-population of information such as facility locations
- Sortable tables
- Improved summaries of survey data
- Facility Improvement Plan (FIP) enhancements

Making this transition requires a lot of work and we are asking for support from agencies and sites in a number of ways. Transitioning to the new site and loading historical data will require that we shut down the application for a period of time. **The PbS, CbS and CJCA websites will be in a blackout status from July 21 through July 28.** During this period, there will be no availability of any of the PbS website functionality. This applies to all assigned users inclusive of PbS Coaches and PbS staff. A few things to note about the upcoming transition:

- **All historical outcomes will migrate as well as FIPs.**
- We will not lose prior data collections, but prior data collection forms, specifically the Administrative Form, Incident Reports, Youth Climate Surveys, Staff Climate Surveys, Youth Exit Interviews, and Youth Records, will not migrate to the new application. **If you need or want any of your historical data collection forms you will need to make electronic copies between now and July 20.**

**Youth Exit Interviews entered between June 1 and the time we transition to the new application, July 20, will migrate to the new CJCA/PbS application.** After the blackout period from July 21-July 28, you can continue to enter Youth Exit Interviews into the new website for the October 2010 data collection.
