

PbS Continues to Expand the Family-Youth Initiative

It is an exciting time for Performance-based Standards (PbS)! New PbS survey kiosks were released that allow youths, staff and families to complete surveys on touch screens. PbS partnered with THRIVE and the Maine Department of Corrections, Division of Juvenile Services to integrate trauma-informed care with PbS, starting by adding new trauma-related questions to the PbS Youth Climate Survey.



The number of surveys for corrections in the FYI pilot has steadily increased. PbS is projected to collect 845 surveys for the April 2014 collection.

PbS is also launching the Family-Youth Initiative (FYI) for all facilities and programs to further improve family engagement and maintaining and strengthening the connection between incarcerated youths and their families. Correction, detention and community-based programs will see many exciting improvements in May!
